### What is "T-V LINK"?

"T-V LINK" allows the TV to share information easily with a connected "T-V LINK" compatible device. By using T-V LINK:

## **Technical information**

### What is "T-V LINK"?

"T-V LINK" allows the TV to share information easily with a connected "T-V LINK" compatible device. By using T-V LINK:

- You can send the channel information programmed on the TV to the "T-V LINK" compatible device, so that both the TV and the external device have the same channel settings. When connecting a new external device, channel information is loaded into it, allowing channel setup to be completed very quickly. For more details, refer to the external device's manual.
- You can easily record the TV programme you are viewing on a "T-V LINK" compatible device by using the "DIRECT REC" feature. For more details, refer to the external device's manual.

### What is "ACI" (Automatic Channel Installation)?

Some cable companies transmit a signal called "ACI" which contains information that allows TV channels to be registered automatically on your TV.
